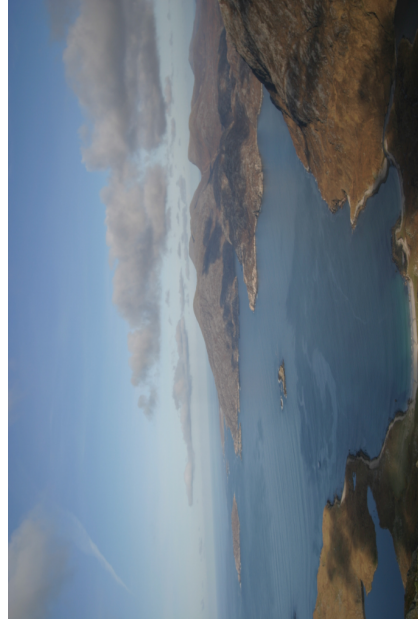

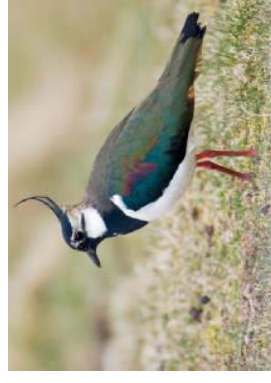

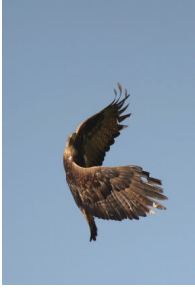
Tuesday 18th May

Guided Walk from Huisinis to Loch na Cleabhaig with North Harris Ranger -

Meet at Huisinis carpark (NA 992 120) at **10am-2:30pm**, Distance: 5 miles

This varied circular walk takes you across machair, past white sand beaches, into the North Harris

hills. As well as learning about the flora of the machair there are good chances of seeing some of the Western Isles most iconic species including eagles, otters, and red deer. Saturday Art Class at An Lanntair's Education Room, Kenneth Street, Stornoway.

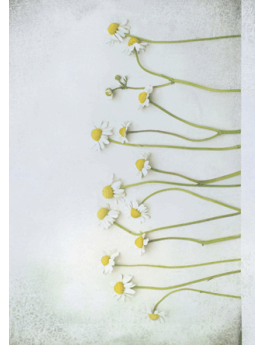
A visual arts workshop for primary school pupils on animation with the theme of plants growing.

Saturday 22nd May

Bag a Beinn – A guided walk with the North Harris Ranger

Meet at Bowglass car park (NB 185 115) at **10am-2pm**, Distance: 5 miles

This walk follows the Bhiogdail track to its highest point, then ascends Liuthard to the north for views over Loch Langavat and Loch Seaforth, Scotlands longest sea loch. This will be an opportunity to look and listen for summer migrants, most of which will just have arrived on their breeding grounds. Part of this walk takes a route across rough hill ground.
