



CROWN ESTATE: YEAR 2 ALLOCATIONS

Report by Director for Assets, Finance and Resources

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To allow Members to consider how the revenues arising from the 2018/19 Crown Estate allocation should be applied.

COMPETENCE

- 1.1 This Report is concerned with the allocation of funding which may vary from year to year. There are no legal or other constraints to the recommendations being implemented.

SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Comhairle received £1.7m of the £7.5m generated by the Crown Estate in Scotland in 2017/18.
- 2.2 In December 2019, in the light of community conversations led by the Director of Education, Skills and Children's Services during the preceding year the Comhairle agreed to distribute the funding as follows:
 - (i) £100k be allocated for the delivery of regional marine planning and Crown Estate asset management;
 - (ii) £30k to support the development of a Community Partnership Board or other community governance model in each of the 12 identified community areas. The essential components of this being that they must be a formally constituted group with the capacity to deliver services on behalf of their community (£360k in total);
 - (iii) £22.5K (£15K for Lewis and Harris; £7.5K for Uist and Barra) to support athletes travel costs; and
 - (iv) £97.5k per ward for infrastructure works and £38k for community projects (£1,220k).
- 2.3 A further round of consultations was undertaken in early 2020 and application forms and guidance were issued to communities. However, the COVID-19 pandemic disrupted this work and the Comhairle agreed to extend the deadline for submissions to 31 May 2020.
- 2.4 The submissions have now been evaluated by officers and Meetings will be held with Ward members to determine how to allocate the funding. Whilst decision on Year 1 projects are imminent to date there has been no spend in relation to items (i) and (ii) above.
- 2.5 On 18 June 2020, the Budget Board considered a presentation on the Crown Estate funding and the general view expressed by Members was a wish to continue with the same funding model for Year 2. However, it was also agreed that Members would consult with the other Members in their Ward.
- 2.6 The Comhairle received notification of its allocation from the 2018/19 net revenues of the Crown Estate on 2 July 2020. An increase in overall revenues to £9.7m means the Comhairle will receive £2.3m.
- 2.7 The Budget Board further considered the matter at its meeting on 9 July 2020 and, whilst generally supporting the same approach in Year 2, deferred any decision pending a review of the projects to be funded in Year 1.
- 2.8 Appendix A provides a complete list of the projects submitted and indicates those that were successful. The scale of bids in each ward area varied but it is difficult to assess how well this reflects demand.
- 2.9 In the light of these outcomes it is proposed that in relation to Year 1 funding that has not yet been utilised that:
 - (i) the £100k for regional marine planning and Crown Estate asset management be carried over into Year 2;
 - (ii) the £22.5k for athlete travel be carried over into Year 2 on the basis it will be recurring in future but has not been able to be used this year;
 - (iii) the unused part of the £360k to support the development of community forums be carried over and area forums that have not yet applied for it; and
 - (iv) any residual funding in any area be carried over into Year 2 for that ward.
- 2.10 In respect of the Year 2 allocation it is proposed that:
 - (i) £1,485k of the funding (the equivalent of £165k per ward) be devolved to community forums for projects that benefit coastal communities; and
 - (ii) the balance of the Year 2 funding (£810k) be used to create a Community Economic Fund to support projects that will grow the Outer Hebrides Economy.

2.11 Following further discussion on area forums it is proposed that the Comhairle should establish the following 12 fora:

- Barra
- South Uist
- North Uist
- Harris
- Lochs
- Uig and Bernera
- Breasclete/Carloway
- Barvas to Ness
- Point
- Stornoway South
- Stornoway North
- Loch a Tuath

2.12 The original concept for the devolving of funding.

2.13 In relation to the distribution of the £1,485k the Comhairle could decide to:

- (a) retain the Year 1 model with £165k allocated per ward. Where the ward covers more than one area forum local members will determine how funding should be allocated between the forums;
- (b) allocate funding for each area forum using area populations (this would see the funding weighted towards Broadbay and Stornoway); or
- (c) allocate the funding equally between the forums (this would see the funding weighted more towards rural areas).

2.14 The Budget Board is invited to consider which distribution to recommend to the Comhairle.

2.15 In relation to the £810k it is proposed that and that the Director for Communities, in consultation with the Chief Executive and Directors, present criteria for the use of this to the September series of meetings.

2.16 The increase in Crown Estate funding presents a valuable opportunity for the Comhairle at a critical time and it is important that the Comhairle makes use of this in a strategic and timely fashion.

RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 It is recommended that the Comhairle agree to:

- (a) adopt the 12 community forum areas set out in paragraph 2.11 of the Report;**
- (b) agree the proposals for the unused funding from Year 1 as set out in section 2.9 of the Report;**
- (c) for Year 2 allocate £165k per ward (£1,485k in total) on the basis that where the ward covers more than one area forum local members will determine how funding should be allocated between the forum areas; and**
- (d) use the balance of the Year 2 funding (£810k) to create a Community Economic Fund to support projects that will grow the Outer Hebrides Economy on the basis that this will fund projects across the Outer Hebrides.**
