Pointers Boys Group are meeting weekly with a core group of eight boys. They are currently working on their Dynamic Youth Award and have undertaken the following issue based activities; Team Building; Drug Awareness; Sea Safety and First Aid. Pointers Girls Group are meeting weekly and has a core group of eight girls. They have been working towards a Bronze Youth Achievement Award. They have completed issue based activities covering: Sexual Health; Sexual Violence Prevention; Healthy Living and Healthy Eating. Young Carers Group are meeting weekly in Pointers with a core group of six. Young Mums Group meets weekly and there is a core group of 1 mums. Topics covered recently include: Sexual Health; Baby Massage; Weaning baby; Food on a Budget and Play at Home. weekly and there is a core group of 11 mums. First round of DofE Leader training has already taken place. Meetings/training have taken place to oversee and support both the DofE Uist Open Group and the Sgoil Lionacleit Group. 14 young people in the Broadbay DofE group took part in Bronze Expedition Training with route planned and dates set for qualifying expedition. Duke of Edinburgh Award has been implemented in Barra in May 2014 and there are seven Bronze and six Silver participants. In Harris three DofE Bronze Expedition groups are preparing their routes and paperwork as well as two Gold groups. One Gold group in Harris has completed their Expedition. Two meetings have taken place with the Nicolson DofE group and all young people have been contacted by phone/email to see how they are progressing and if they are still doing award and if they are wanting to do their expedition and work with leader to have training and expedition done when the school goes back in August/September 2014.

Funding, programme, travel, risk assessments and all other arrangements in place for a Gaelic residential to take place between 30th June and 2nd July 2014. Ten Ceol na Cloinne members have attended weekly practice sessions as well as two full day workshops with specialist tuition in fiddle, accordion, piping and singing/guitar. A further full day workshop will take place on 14th July. The group are performing in Seallam on 1st July as part of their preparation for the Hebridean Celtic Festival.

Barra Summer Holiday Programme has been distributed and names have been put down for this programme in July 2014. Attended meetings and contributed to programme design for the Holiday Club in Uist that will take place in partnership with Education & Children's Services and NHS Western Isles during July and August 2014.

Initial discussions have taken place with Head Teachers of Uist Primary schools re piloting Dynamic Youth awards. Meetings have taken place with the new Nicolson Institute Employability group in June. The group consists of nine new learners and initial introductions have taken place. All pupils in S5/6 in Sir E Scott School participated in at least one Personal Development Activity which included Leaving Home Sessions, Intergenerational Work in partnership with Harris House, Pupils in Sir E Scott School are working on completing Youth Achievement Awards and Duke of Edinburgh's Awards as part of their personal achievement and were recently awarded Saltire Awards for their work. The partnership between Castlebay School, Volunteer Centre and Community Education has enabled all young people to be recognised and acknowledged for their volunteering and 100% of pupils have signed up for Saltire awards and are being supported jointly by volunteer centre, school and community education. Initial meetings have taken place before the school holidays to meet new classes and explain the SQA Rural Skills and Employability courses starting in August.
