



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**COMHAIRLE NAN EILEAN SIAR**  
**(DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2013**

**TRO-13/04**

Comhairle nan Eilean Siar in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of that Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the "Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (Disabled Persons' Parking Places ) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on [date].
2. Subject to paragraph 3 below, the effect of the Order will be to prohibit any person from parking at any time, any vehicle in a designated Disabled Persons' Parking Place as defined in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto.
3. The prohibition provided for in paragraph 2 above shall not apply where the vehicle parked in the designated Disabled Persons' Parking Place is displaying a Blue Badge as defined in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

This is the Schedule referred to in the foregoing Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2013.

### **PART 1 – Interpretation**

- (1) “Blue Badge” means a badge issued in accordance with section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 or non-UK equivalent.
- (2) “designated Disabled Persons Parking Place” means any space designated as parking for disabled persons, by virtue of this Order and as more particularly described in Part 2 of this Schedule.

## **PART 2 – Disabled Parking Places in Stornoway**

The Parking spaces referred to in the foregoing Order are described below and shown on Plan 1 annexed and executed as relative hereto.

<b>Parking Place reference and as shown on Plan 1</b>	<b>Location and description</b>	<b>Number of spaces at location</b>
1	<i>Perceval Square Car Park, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> Three parking bays within Perceval Square Car Park, situated to the West of 20 Cromwell Street. The bays are at right angles to the northern boundary of the civic area.	3
2	<i>Carn Gardens, South Beach, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> Three parking bays located three metres or thereby south of Carn Gardens within a layby and parallel to the carriageway of South Beach Street and bounded on the South by said carriageway.	3
3	<i>South Beach Car Park, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> Two bays situated within South Beach Car Park, adjacent and at right angles to the Northern boundary wall of said car park, opposite the premises at 21-23 South Beach Street.	2
4	<i>South Beach Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> One bay within the layby at 37 South Beach Street, situated parallel to the carriageway of South Beach Street and bounded on the South by said carriageway.	1
5	<i>Kenneth Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis</i> One bay situated on the West side of Kenneth Street, seven metres or thereby north of the junction with Francis Street. The bay is parallel to the footpath.	1
6	<i>North Beach Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> One bay situated at 7 North Beach Street. The bay is parallel to the footpath and is three metres or thereby from the Quay Street junction.	1
7	<i>Francis Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> One bay at 13 Francis Street. The bay is within a layby and is parallel to the footpath.	1
8	<i>South Beach Street:</i> One bay at 11 South Beach Street eight metres west or thereby of the Castle Street junction. The bay is within a parking area and is at right angles to and bounded on the South by the carriageway at South Beach Street.	1

**Notes to accompany the formal Order and not part of the formal Order**

In the formal Order, descriptions of the bays are deliberately geographical rather than by reference to premises as presently occupied (eg "21-23" South Beach Street" rather than "the Clydesdale Bank". This is deliberate as occupants of premises can change relatively easily.

For ease of reference for the current proposals, noted below is additional information regarding the location of the bays, using current premises as landmark points:

1	<i>Perceval Square Car park, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> Three parking bays within the Perceval Square Car Park, at 20 Cromwell Street (Stornoway Trust Office).	3
2	<i>Carn Gardens, South Beach, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> Three parking bays at Carn Gardens on the north of South Beach Street (between Tighean Innse Gall Office and the Town Hall).	3
3	<i>South Beach Car Park, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> Two parking bays within the car park opposite 21-23 South Beach Street (The Clydesdale Bank).	2
4	<i>South Beach Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> One parking bay at 37 South Beach Street (Health Board Offices).	1
5	<i>Kenneth Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis</i> One parking bay at the Gazette shop, on Kenneth Street side.	1
6	<i>North Beach Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> One parking bay at 7 North Beach St (Opticians).	1
7	<i>Francis Street, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis:</i> One parking bay at 13 Francis Street (Job Centre).	1
8	<i>South Beach Street:</i> One parking bay at 11 South Beach Street (DWP Office).	1
