### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The principal reason for introducing this Order is in the interests of improving road safety and traffic management.

The proposed Order effectively has two parts, to amend the Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (20mph Speed Limit) at Schools Order 2006 by (1) the addition of schools to the list and (2) removing some schools from the 2006 list, by reason of their having been since closed.

The Order will make enforceable the variable speed limits of 20mph adjacent to schools, The variable speed limits will apply at the peak times of the start and end of the school day and on other occasions as required; the operation of the variable speed limit will be marked by operation of flashing amber signage at the main approaches to the schools. The Order is intended to improve road safety, making school environments safer where a significant volume of pedestrian and/or vehicular traffic is present.
