STATEMENT OF REASONS

The reason for implementing this order is in the interests of road safety and traffic management.

There is an existing problem on Bayhead Street with long stay parking, mainly due to vehicles for sale occupying the parking area on the west side of the street. The Order will ensure there is a turnover of parked cars, freeing up parking spaces for access to the shopping areas of Stornoway and Bayhead.

The one way system on the section of Scotland Street will allow traffic to flow freely in one direction. At present traffic flow in both directions is restricted with parked cars on one side of the street. The junction between Kenneth Street and Scotland Street has restricted visibility. The one way system will mean vehicles will not have to give way at this junction.
