- Map showing Local Place Plan for Harris Leverburgh in detail was discussed.
- Discussion about whether school catchment areas are enforced.
- Cllr Finnegan has entered meeting at 8pm
- Food Bank Suggest to Mairi MacIver that SHCC share advertising of box within Hub. An outdoor area at the back of the Hub was suggested as being a possibility.
- Leverburgh Pier Suggestion to make perimeter of fence at fisherman's yard and car parks look better by planting. Outer Hebrides Development plan mentions on Pg 10 about enhancing this area.
- Leverburgh Pier Enhancement Group Put in touch with Eva so that those plans are included **Donnie and Stephen**.
- Shuttle buses for tourists as an aspiration.
- Traffic calming measures outside school and Clachan corner to be included.

- Recap of current situation by the Chair.
- Sub-group met with Alastair Allan MSP recently. Letter sent to SEPA after meeting they have offered to meet Alastair Allan and sub-group.
- Frustration at lack of action from CNES and SEPA to work with Professor Jill Robbie..
- 6. Northton Grazings -
- Issue of derelict vehicles on Northton Machair. One of the vehicles has been moved within a month of asking. No further reply from Grazings committee re request to move vehicles initial reply was that vehicles are on machair crofting land rather than common grazings.

- 1 car on Common Grazings land have been told its due to be moved by the individual.
- Bob to approach individual on behalf of SHCC re two cars on crofting land.
- 7. Scarista Scout Bus Quote received, and Donnie will present to Scout Association for acceptance.
- 8. Housing Update -
- First 5 allocated, next 7 will be allocated by end of September.
- Housing in Scarista Church of Scotland due to sell land to the West Harris Trust, part of the glebe.
- HHP, TIG involved in discussions regarding building 7 houses on this land. No planning application has gone to the council yet.
- Report put together by some residents outlining concerns, this has been communicated to SHCC. Chair has suggested they set up as a group and a spokesperson interacts with the SHCC.
- Sub-Group Donnie, Bob, Effie, Patricia (Donnie will speak to).
- 9. Playpark –
- Fire Brigade car wash raised £682 for playpark.
- Playpark equipment dismantled last week.
- £3,600 in funds, and £75k from CNES, so far. Possibility of further grant funding.
- Old bank account and old committee members have been found, and old constitution will be resurrected. This is being worked on.
- Alex Murray groundworks Lucy to check if approach has been made.
- 10. Grant Funding Received from Foundation Scotland and Coastal Community Fund for Rodel Toilets and Community Garden. Thank you to Marion and Stephen for their efforts.
- 11. Other funding opportunities Eva has circulated various funding opportunities. SHCC will circulate to other groups.
- 12. Sheep in Village Donnie has been in touch with Common Grazings Clerk no response yet. There should be no sheep in Leverburgh, particularly bad issue at new houses.
- 13. Potholes in Borrisdale and Strond -
- Thanks to both Councillors again for Northton road resurfacing.

- Potholes have been filled in Borrisdale, Strond still waiting. Cllr Finnegan to check if any more money available. Ferry Road surface also requires attention.
- 14. Visitor Levy Delayed by at least a year. Western Isles, Orkney, Shetland and other holding back to see impact in Edinburgh. A port of entry looks like being a more likely method.
