

Woodburner / Open Fire Instructions

- If you have a wood burning stove or a fire in the hearth, use a fire guard, and don't leave any combustible material anywhere near the wood burning stove or fireplace.
- Only appropriate wood (supplied) to be used in fire – avoid overloading the fire / woodburner
- Strictly no additional fuel to be put on fire after 22.00
- Guest to wear PPE (gloves) and use appropriate metal tools to empty fireplace
- Foam fire extinguisher kept adjacent to fireplace.
- Ensure children are kept away from fire / woodburner at all times and guard is used.
- Ash must not be cleared from the fireplace until the next morning or once ash is cool
- A metal bucket with lid (which is provided) must be used to transfer ash outside using PPE and only once ash is cool
- Under no circumstances is ash to be allowed to accumulate in the bucket
- Once ash removed outside, it must be placed in the galvanised bin, with lid fitted and secured
- Brush the bucket prior to returning indoors with brush provided
- Ensure that all ovens and gas hobs, if applicable, are switched off before you go to bed, and when the property is unoccupied.
- Please ensure that all other residents read this document and know what they need to do in the event of a fire.

These instructions are for your safety in the unlikely event of an emergency – please enjoy a safe, happy and relaxed holiday!
