Ferry Access: notice received that tenders were out for the supply of a new gangway.

School: Concerns have been raised that the Comhairle is not adequately considering the demand for English-medium education in Breasclete, and children are being automatically given a place at Shawbost or Lochs. The clerk will contact the Parent Council for an update.

AOB: A report received by a member regarding a loose dog. Person to be advised to contact police.

Date of next meeting: Next meeting will be Wednesday 9th September, after the August break.

N4 Q&A.
Q. Reason for reducing the number of turbines.
A. Visual Impact reduction. Geo-physical work has not yet been completed so may be able to reduce further later on.
Q. When will the Sub-station options be decided?
A. After consent.
Q. When will the project go to planning? A. Estimated late Autumn
Q. Re access road for cable. What is the depth of peat? A. Variable, but average depth not known. Probing has been done and more to be done. Deeper areas will need wider access, and there will potentially be a floating road at some points.
Q. On the potential for young people, capabilities of local people, work with UHI.
A. Working with UHI and schools. Stem co-ordinators are working in schools and UHI, and scholarships in Gaelic and Stem are being awarded. There are numerous strands and ongoing collaboration with other organisations.
Q. Will Community Benefit be index-linked? A. Yes

A. Scottish Government has approved this. The converter station has been consented.
