arising/	A) Roads, Streetlights; PMG, IMN and Cllr Ùisdean Robertson met with Calum Mackenzie (CMK) Head of Assets and did walk around of Horve to highlight areas

from last meeting:	B) Road markings: Road surfacing due to take place 10th &11th May. CNES will issue out information prior to this date.

4) Abandoned Cars	D) Crash Barriers; The lack of crash barriers at corner outside Castlebay leading to BenTangabhal was raised. E) Drains; Cllr IMN wrote to SEPA and spoke to Head of Environmental Services regarding smell of sewage from septic tank at Horve. Still awaiting reply. F) Culvert at Bridge in Horve; CMK intimated they would not replace culvert at this present time. G) Ballcourt upgrade; Ballcourt area was discussed with CMK in regards to the Community Council taking over the lease and discussion took place about how the area was going to be upgraded and developed into a community 2G Astro Turf Pitch. Funding is required as shortfall of £20,000 to help pay for groundworks and installation. H) School/hub; PMQ raised the concern with CMK regarding the school maintenance plan and heating. KML has raised this with Donald McLeod Director of Education who is down in Barra for next PC meeting. Pier association has cut up abandoned cars that have been left at Vatersay Causeway with a view to making them easier to remove. Abandoned car at Garrygall quarry has been reported. Any abandoned cars need to be taken to market stance in Benbecula where CNES do uplifts. Some discussion over the benefit of costing for a compactor to make process of moving these vehicles easier. However, it was agreed that this issue will require further discussion with Colin Fraser as this is a complicated issue to resolve in terms of logistics. It was agreed there was a lack of parity for Barra & Vatersay residents.	KD to apply to various funding bodies for funds to help raise this money CLLR KML will raise this issue again with Director of Education CLLR IMN to liaise with Colin Fraser to establish next steps and seek advice on removal of abandoned cars
5) Hub Update - New School/Care Facility	Cllr IMN advised that the project board have met and looked at options for build. CnES will be making 11.4m contribution to the school but there is still a shortfall re hospital costs. Costs have risen substantially since costing of original project. Significant shortfall means that there may be potential borrowing and that sustained political pressure will be required. Cllr KML is hosting a cross-party meeting so as to engage all parties to include the project in all manifestos.	Cllr KML to update Post cross-party meeting

After having sought and reviewed quotes - HMK proposed that grant allocation be used for following works- Reinstall barrels Repair dry stone walling Add flower and palm tree features All CC members agreed that this was a good use of funding and thanked HMK for her input. HMK also plans to engage further with Community regarding Island Plan through interactive feedback form online in order to help identify main priorities specific to Barra. 9) Castle Update	SAML met with Jamie McPherson- the Head of North Region at Historic Environment Scotland HES on the 11 th March. He is overseeing conservation works at Kisimul Castle, including the installation of new support systems and safe access for masonry inspections. He advised of the following: • Slipway repairs are underway • Overall risk status has been deescalated following recent inspections • Outstanding main issues are - new forestairs outside tower /great hall stabilisation through concrete block and heavy timbers • Digital team have made online 3D Castle (Sketchpad) • Digital Team have made 2x large 3D models of Castle, one of which will be given to the school. • Detailed Works programme timeline proposes Castle reopens in August 26.
