## COMATAIDH NA GÀIDHLIG: SENIOR PHASE GAELIC SURVEY – RESULTS

30 APRIL 2024

### PURPOSE

- 1.1 This Report provides information concerning the results of a survey of Senior Phase (S4-S6) pupils' attitudes to Gaelic that was carried out in Autumn 2023.

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2.1 A survey, including 23 questions, was carried out in Autumn 2023 of the views of Senior Phase pupils across the four islands' secondary schools about Gaelic and Gaelic Medium Education. 382 pupils in total completed the survey, and this contained a mix of Gaelic Medium Education (GME) and English Medium Education (EME) pupils.
- 2.2 The results and observations, which are detailed in the Appendix to this Report, will be used to inform Gaelic development strategy in the Comhairle.

- Tha an Aithisg seo a' toirt seachad fiosrachadh mu thoraidhean suirbhidh air beachdan sgoilearan an ìre as àirde (ÀS4-ÀS6) air Gàidhlig a chaidh a chumail as t-Foghar 2023.

### GEÀRR-CHUNNTAS

Chaidh suirbhidh, le 23 ceistean, a chumail as t-Foghar 2023 mu bheachdan sgoilearan an ìre as àirde sna ceithir àrd-sgoiltean sna h-eileanan air Gàidhlig agus Foghlam tro Mheadhan na Gàidhlig. Chrìochnaich 382 sgoilear an suirbhidh, measgachadh de sgoilearan Foghlam tro Mheadhan na Gàidhlig (FtG) agus sgoilearan Foghlam tro Mheadhan na Beurla (FtB).

Thèid na toraidhean agus an sgrùdadh a chaidh a dhèanamh orra, a tha mìnichte ann an doimhneachd san Fha-sgrìobhadh den Aithisg seo, a cheachdadh gus taic a chur ri obair leasachadh na Gàidhlig sa Chomhairle.

## SUMMARY OF MAIN FINDINGS

5.1

- 382 pupils in total completed the survey, 134 in GME and 248 in EME.
- Only 41% of all pupils asked said they were interested in using Gaelic in their future career. The figure for EME pupils was only 21%.
- Only 39% of all pupils thought that the Gaelic Senior Phase curriculum was relevant to their needs. This figure is also in line with the 16-25 Gaelic Attitudinal Survey held in Summer 2023 by Sgioba na Gàidhlig, where only 40% thought that the Gaelic curriculum was appropriate to their needs.
- Only 45% of all pupils surveyed thought that enough was being done in school to emphasise the economic benefits of bilingualism. This figure is identical to the figure in the 16-25 Attitudinal Survey who said that

Tha seo coltach ris an àireamh san t-Suirbhidh mu Bheachdan air Gàidhlig am measg dhaoine 16-25 a chaidh a chumail as t-Samhradh 2023 le Sgioba na Gàidhlig, far nach robh ach 40% dhen bheachd gun robh an curraicealam Gàidhlig iomchaidh.
- Cha robh ach 45% de sgoilearan gu lèir dhen bheachd gun robhar a' déanamh gu leòr gus buannachdan eaconomach dà-chànanais a dh'adhartachadh. Tha am figear seo co-ionann ris an àireamh de dhaoine 16-25 san t-Suirbhidh mu

enough was being done in the Isles to promote Gaelic economically.

- 54% of all pupils felt that their school's ethos was strong enough in terms of hearing and seeing Gaelic.
- Only 51% of all pupils surveyed thought that the benefits of bilingualism were promoted by schools career staff.
- There is a strong perception that having Gaelic skills will assist pupils in terms of looking for jobs locally, with 66% of all pupils believing this to be the case.
- There is very strong support for establishing Gaelic Primary schools (72%) and Secondary schools (66%) in the isles as an initiative to support and develop the language. These percentages included a large number of pupils who had indicated that they had very little interest in Gaelic, but who, nevertheless, thought that such schools would be a positive development for Gaelic.

5.2 In combining the results of the Senior Phase 5.2 Gaelic Survey and the 16-25 Gaelic Attitudinal Survey, (providing a total sample size of 704), only 48% said that the economic benefits of bilingualism were properly promoted in school, and only 40% thought that Gaelic Senior Phase courses were relevant.

Bheachdan air Gàidhlig a thuirt gun robhar a' dèanamh gu leòr gus Gàidhlig a dh'adhartachadh gu h-economach.

- Bha 54% de sgoilearan dhen bheachd gun robh an fheallsanachd aig sgoiltean làidir gu leòr a thaobh a bhith a' faicinn is a' cluinnntinn Gàidhlig.
- Cha robh ach 51% de sgoilearan dhen bheachd gun robh luchd-obrach dhreuchdan sna sgoiltean ag adhartachadh bhuanachdan dà-chànanais.
- Tha beachd làidir ann gu bheil sgilean Gàidhlig na chuideachadh dha sgoilearan nuair a thig e gu bhith a' lorg obair gu h-iondail, le 66% de sgoilearan dhen bheachd seo.
- Tha taic làidir ann airson Bun-sgoiltean Gàidhlig (72%) agus airson Àrd-sgoiltean Gàidhlig (66%) sna h-eileanan, gus taic a chumail ris a' chànan agus gus an cànan a leasachadh. Tha seo a' gabhail a-steach àireamh mhòr de sgoilearan a thuirt nach robh tòrr ùidh sam bith aca sa Ghàidhlig, ach a bha dhen bheachd, an dèidh sin, gum b' e deagh rud a bhiodh ann dha leasachadh na Gàidhlig.

Ann a bhith a' cur thoraidhean Suirbhidh Sgoilearan Àrd-ìre agus thoraidhean Suirbhidh mu Bheachdan air Gàidhlig am measg dhaoine 16-25 còmhla, (a' toirt dhuinn àireamh de 704 duine gu lèir), cha robh ach 48% dhen bheachd gun robhar ag adhartachadh bhuanachdan eaconomach dà-chànanais mar bu chòir, agus cha robh ach 40% dhen bheachd gun robh cursaichean Gàidhlig an Àrd-ìre iomchaidh.
