PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of the Report is to provide an update on the membership of the Budget and Strategy Board.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Comhairle appointed members to the Budget and Strategy Board in June 2022 with a remit to oversee the detail of the Comhairle's budget throughout the year and implementation of the Comhairle's Budget Strategy. The remit was extended in December 2022 to include consideration of policy and strategy development and to act as a political sounding board. The Comhairle further agreed to extend the membership by appointing Cllr Donald F Crichton as the remaining chair not already a member of the Board and Cllr Gordon Murray as the remaining political group leader not currently on the Board.
- 2.2 Dr Frances Murray has been elected as the new Leader of the SNP Group and was invited to replace Cllr Gordon Murray at the last meeting of the Budget and Strategy Board.
