PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of the Report is to seek approval for the proposed public and local holidays in 2026 together with the proposed programme of Committee and Comhairle meetings.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2.1 The draft Comhairle Year Planner for 2026 appended to the Report sets out the proposed pattern of meetings for Committees and the Comhairle together with suggested local and public holidays. The series in March/April has been brought forward to take account of the Scottish Parliament Election and Easter Holidays. The School Holidays for 2026/27 will be included in the Year Planner following confirmation by the Chief Officer, Education and Children's Services.
- 2.2 Following approval, the timetable will be passed to Hebridean Housing Partnership, NHS Eileanan Siar and the Integration Joint Board to enable them to take account of the Comhairle's meeting dates when considering their Board meetings for 2026.
- 2.3 For ease of reference the proposed local and public holidays are set out separately in Appendix 2 to the Report. Following agreement of the proposed timetable additional information in relation to timings of other meetings such as the Outer Hebrides Community Planning Partnership, IJB, and CoSLA will be included.
