

The Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (SFRS) is holding a public pre-consultation exercise titled 'Shaping Our Future Service: Your Say'.

This is the first stage in our engagement with communities, staff, representative bodies, partners and elected members as we consider changes to the emergency service we deliver across Scotland.

As a Service we want to do more for our communities – not just by responding to emergency incidents but by stopping them from happening in the first place.

2024 marks 200 years since the establishment of the worlds first municipal fire service in Scotland, the role of a Fire Fighter has evolved over time and we want to build on this success to create a modern service that is ready for the challenges of Scotland's future.

The types of incidents we respond to are changing and different parts of Scotland need different services from us, this means we need to change how we work.

We will be running events and speaking to communities to find out what you want and need from your Fire & Rescue Service. A survey has been created to capture your views.
