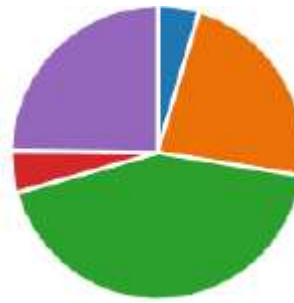


Pointers Youth Centre - consultation results

There were 109 consultations completed.

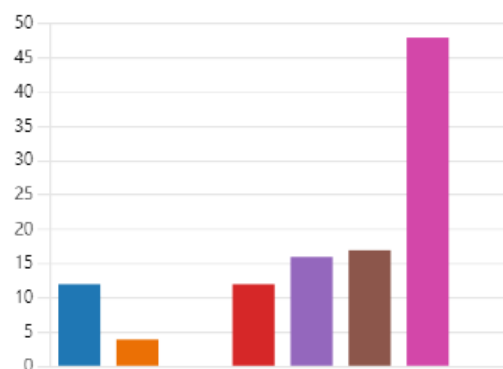
Q 1. How old are you?

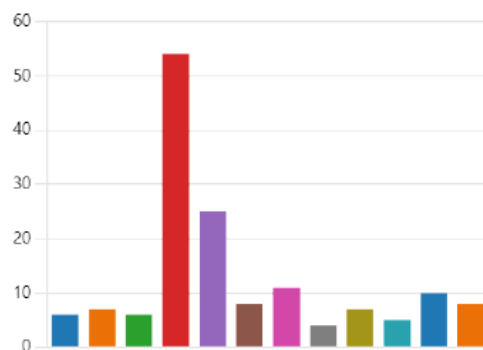

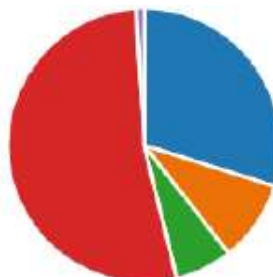

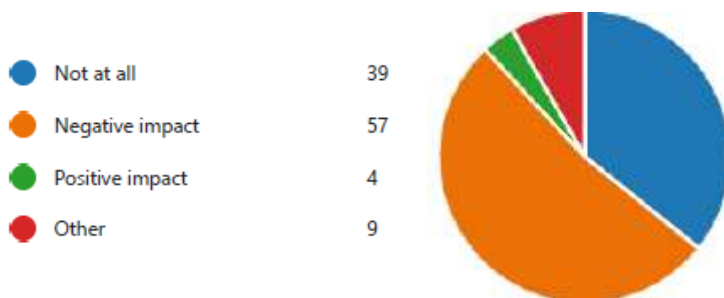
Q 4. The locations listed below have been identified as possible venues for Pointers groups. Would any of these be a suitable alternative?

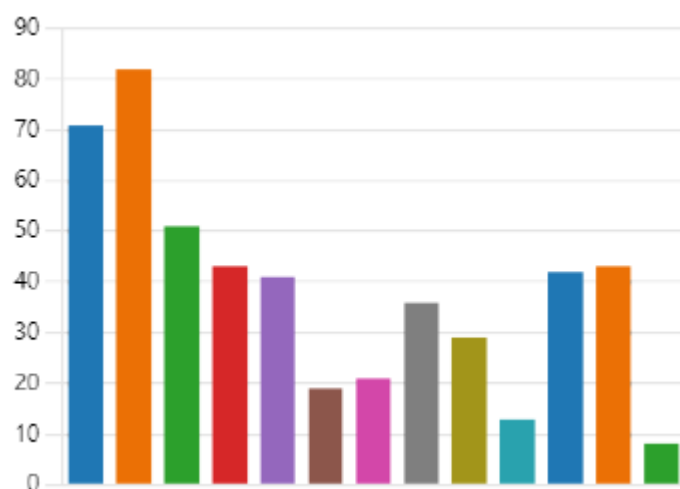
- For the accessibility for the cafe none of the these locations would suit.
