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


- Ten questions

- 232 responses less than 1% of population
 - In comparison with Shetland, this is a similar response rate










Q6 - Do you know how your home will be affected by the proposed new housing standard for energy efficiency?


Q7 - Do you think you will be able to fund any additional works to meet the standard?













Q10 - Age range of respondents
