



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

COMHAIRLE NAN EILEAN SIAR

(DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES ORDER) 2018

Comhairle nan Eilean Siar proposes to make the “Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (Disabled Parking Places Order) 2018” under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The proposed Order will replace the current Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (Disabled Parking Places Order) 2013, incorporating the thirteen Disabled Persons Parking Places that were covered by the 2013 Order and adding a further nine Disabled Persons Parking Places across Stornoway and Tarbert. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any person from parking any vehicle in a Disabled Persons' Parking Place unless a Blue Badge, issued in accordance with the national Blue Badge Scheme, is validly displayed on the vehicle.
