STATEMENT OF REASONS

It is proposed to close the above roads in Stornoway Town Centre between 3pm and 4pm on Saturday 1st June, 2019. The reason for this temporary road closure is to cater for the Hebridean Pride Procession.

The closure will allow for a vehicle free area as the procession moves through the town.

The procession will start from the Lews Castle Grounds and finish at Perceval Square Car Park. The road will be closed from the roundabout, adjacent to Porter's Lodge, as the march proceeds along Bayhead St and Cromwell St towards Perceval Square. North Beach St and the west lane of Castle St will also be closed to prevent any through traffic at this time.

As the procession passes, the road will be re-opened to allow free movement of traffic.

Perceval Square Car Park will be closed from 10pm on Friday 31st May 2019 to 10pm on Saturday 1st June 2019 as the area will be used for the Hebridean Pride event.

Access to the Fisherman's Car Park will be via the Perceval Sq "Exit" on North Beach St.

The closure is in the interest of road safety.
