

Community Skip Service for Bulky Household Waste

Community skips are available for your area through your Community Council or Residents Association. Once the skip has been agreed through the relevant community group, a locked community skip will be sited in various locations in your local area and will be available for the disposal of items of bulky household waste at set times. The skip will be supervised at all times when it is unlocked.

The skip will be available for waste disposal at agreed times which will be publicised by your local Community Council or Residents Association.

This service is for the disposal of bulky household wastes only, as detailed below. The disposal of Commercial and Industrial wastes into the Community Skip is strictly prohibited.

Advice has been provided below for the disposal of waste materials not permitted for disposal into the skip. For more detailed information, please contact the Zero Waste Western Isles team on **01851 70 99 00**.

For this service to continue, it must be used responsibly. Misuse of the skip will result in the service being withdrawn.

The skip will be monitored and any waste materials left at or near to the skip will be regarded as Fly-tipping and reported to the Police and SEPA.

x No Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment:

(e.g. Fridges, Freezers, Microwaves, TVs, Cookers, Computers, Printers, Irons, Kettles, Toasters, Stereos etc.)

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment can easily be recycled if separately collected but if it ends up in a skip of mixed waste it is likely to end up in landfill. For large items, such as white goods, your supplier may be able to offer an uplift service.

Where the demand is sufficient, an alternative skip can be made available in your area for waste electrical equipment.

x No Grass Cuttings

Grass Cuttings are not accepted into the skip as they can be recycled into compost and electricity at the Comhairle's Waste Plant and should be deposited into your Organic Bin.

An additional Organic bin can be provided if extra bin capacity is needed at your home. Please contact the Comhairle's Zero Waste Team on 01851 709900 for details.

Disposal options for wastes that are not suitable for disposal into the Community Skip service.

Fish or Animal By-Products of any kind	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Construction and demolition wastes are classed as Industrial Waste and the waste producer has a Duty to dispose of this type of waste properly and pay any appropriate waste disposal costs even if the producer is a householder carrying out DIY work.		
Construction wastes (including wastes from DIY work)	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Demolition wastes (including wastes from DIY work such as: fireplaces, bathroom suites, windows and doors)	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Asbestos	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Plasterboard	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Stone or rubble	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Soil	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Crofting or farm wastes	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Silage wrap	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Chemicals	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Oil tanks	➔	Bennadrove Landfill Site
Metal parts of stoves or back boilers from DIY repairs (non commercial/trade)	➔	Creed Park Recycling Centre

Metal Car parts from DIY car repairs (non commercial)	➔	Creed Park Recycling Centre
Paints, Oil, Lead Acid Batteries (non commercial/ trade)	➔	Creed Park Recycling Centre
Tyres/ wheels (non commercial)	➔	Creed Park Recycling Centre
Grass cuttings	➔	Organic Bin or Creed Park Recycling Centre
